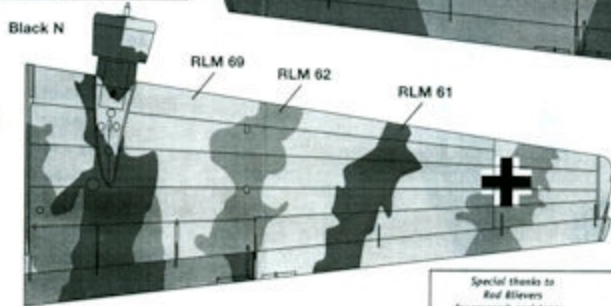

NOTES

Upper Wing Crosses: Both aircraft had thick white arms.

Black N: 1.(F)/123 hack in the Mediterranean. Four-color camouflage: presumably RLM 61/62/69/65. White fuselage band and possibly lower wingtips. Optional unit badge (and separated version) provided; apply to left side of forward fuselage or outboard side of left engine cowling. **Reference A** – page 119.

White O: Unknown unit on the Eastern Front. RLM 70/71/65. Probably yellow fuselage band and lower wingtips. **Reference B** – page 65.
