


STRIKE LEADERS

These two aircraft led the fighter and dive bombing groups of the First Air Fleet's first wave on December 7th, 1941.



A6M2 Zero piloted by LCDR Shigeru Itaya


Al-I55 piloted by LCDR Shigeru Itaya was the first aircraft launched in the attack. Their primary mission was fighter escort and the strafing of ground targets. LCDR Itaya was later shot down over the Kuriles by Imperial Japanese Army pilots.



D3-A2 Val piloted by LCDR Kakuichi Takahashi

El-238 piloted by LCDR Kakuichi Takahashi led the dive bomber contingent of the first wave. Val aircraft of the first wave totalled 51, 26 from the Shokaku and 25 from the Zuikaku. Targets included Ford Island, Hickam Air Base, and Wheeler Air Base.


D3A2 Val piloted by LCDR Kakuichi Takahashi








