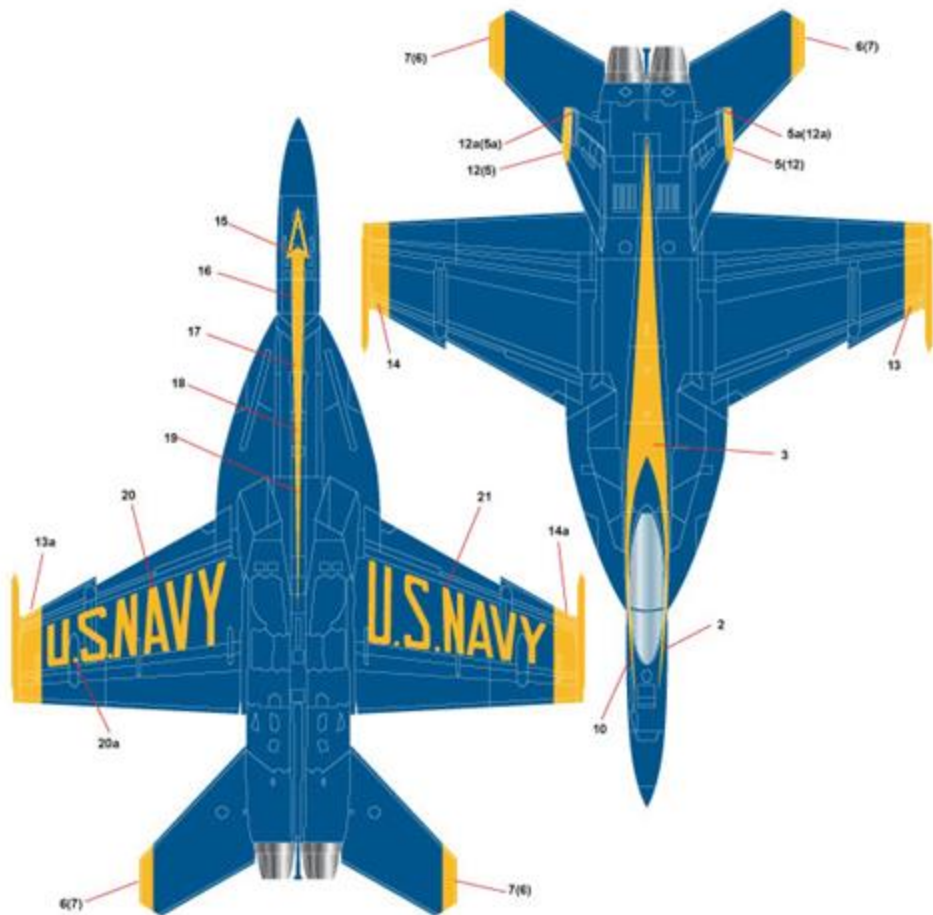

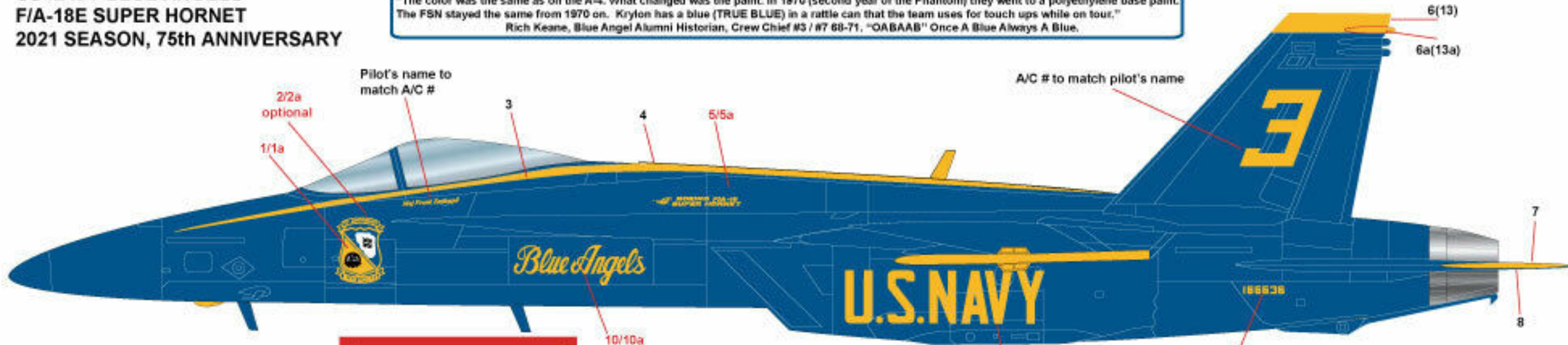

BLUE ANGEL PAINT COLOR INFORMATION
 "The color was the same as on the A-4. What changed was the paint. In 1970 (second year of the Phantom) they went to a polyethylene base paint. The FSN stayed the same from 1970 on. Krylon has a blue (TRUE BLUE) in a rattle can that the team uses for touch ups while on tour."

Apply pilot's name, A/C number and BUNO to both sides of the aircraft in positions indicated. For proper color registration, it is necessary to apply the white layer decals (1a, 2a, 5a, 10a, 12a), pilots' names and BUNOs before applying the yellow decals (1, 2, 5, 10, 12), pilots' names and BUNOs.

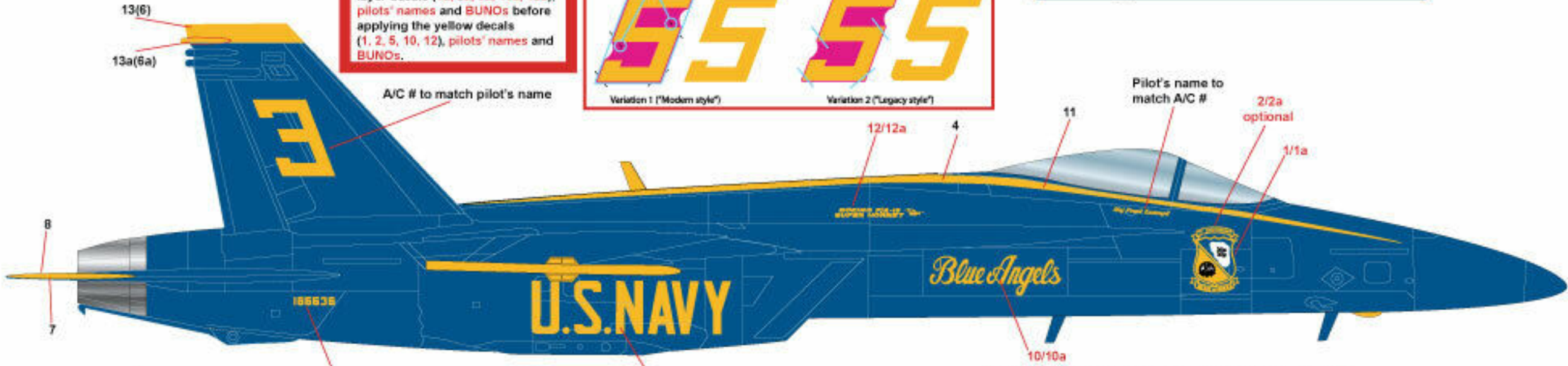
NOTE: Some aircraft carried variations of tail numbers at different times. Trim marks are provided to allow modeler to modify the decals if necessary before application.

Remove all trim marks when cutting decal from backing sheet.

Trim corners of decal using trim marks when cutting from backing sheet.

Some sources state FS15060 as "Blue Angels Blue", but FS1505 is closer. A simple mix to achieve this color is mixing a 1:1 ratio of Testor's #1111 Dark Blue with FS 15044 Insignia Blue

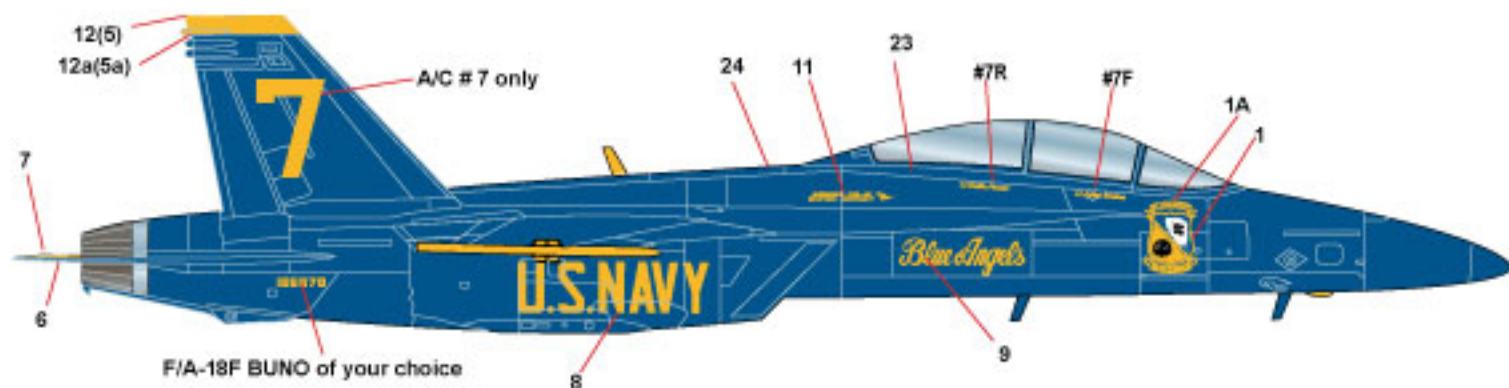
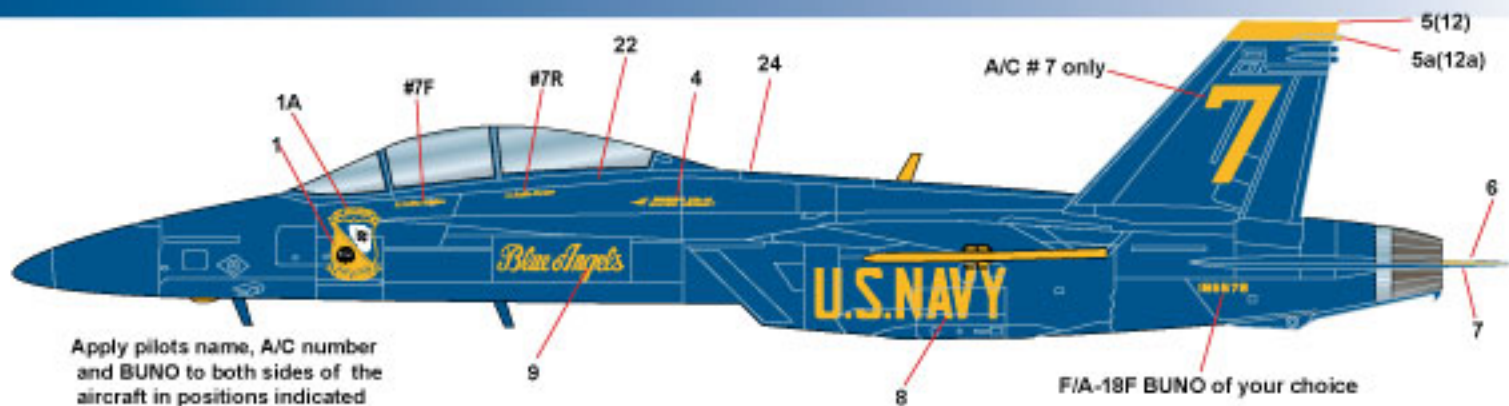
