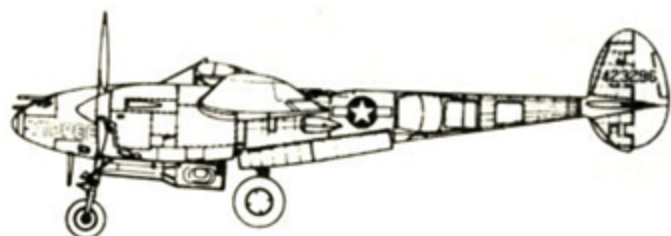

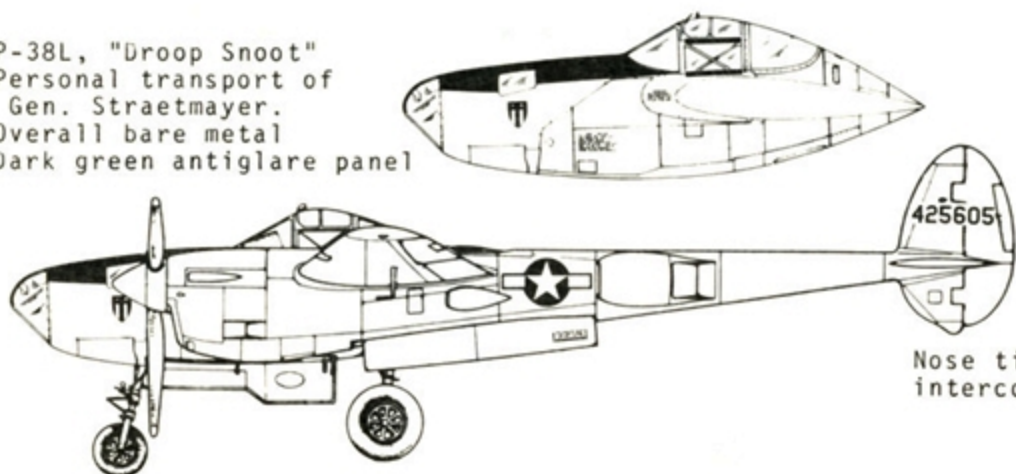

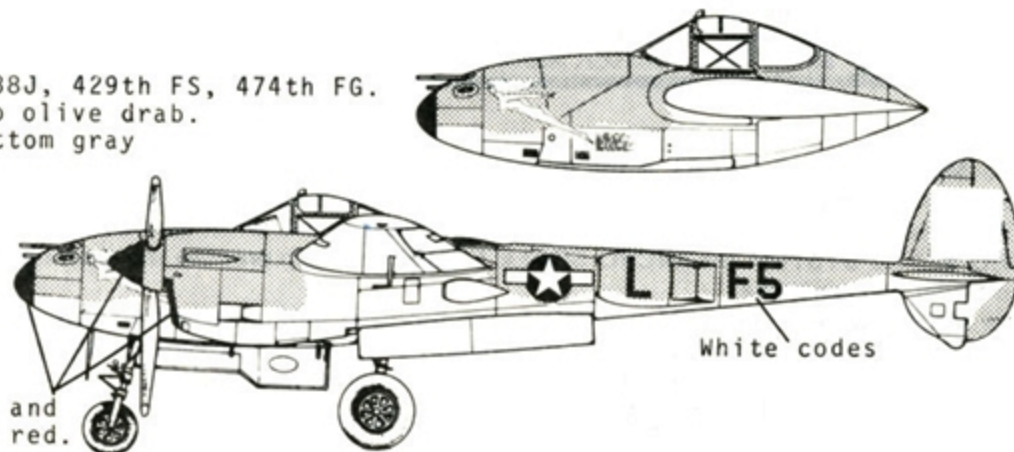

 intercooler scoop red.

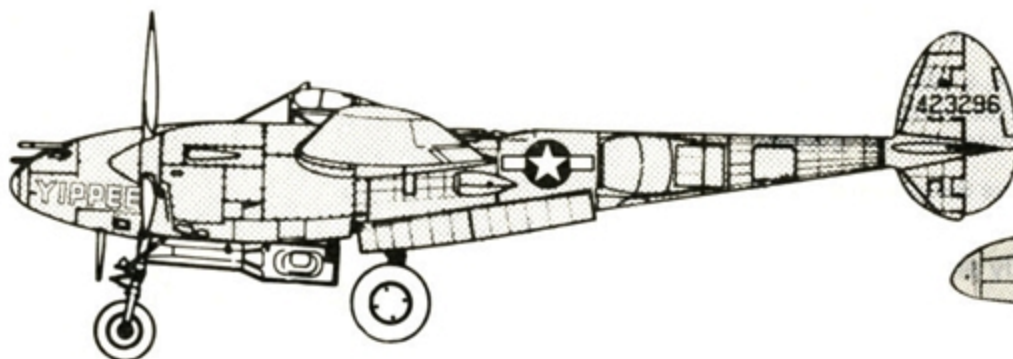

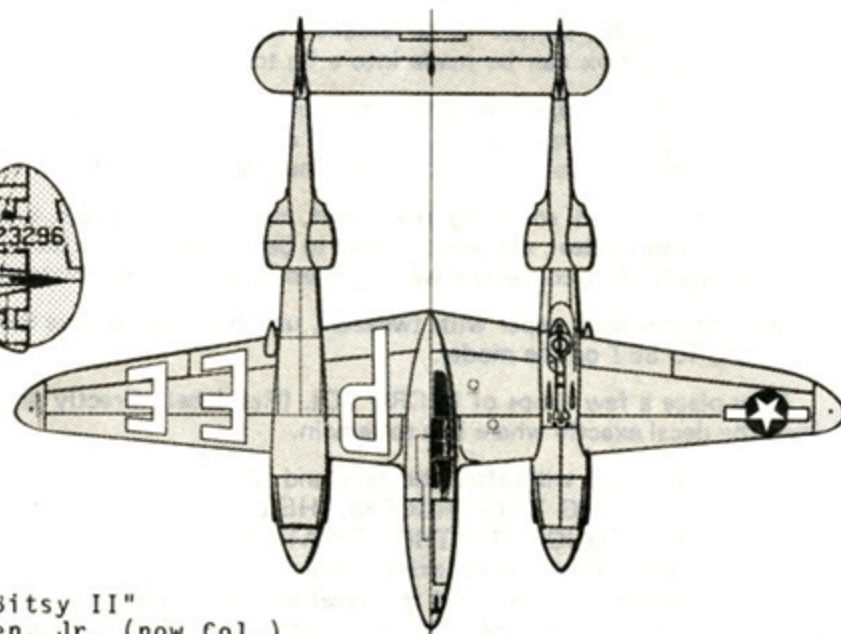

Plan view of "YIPPEE"

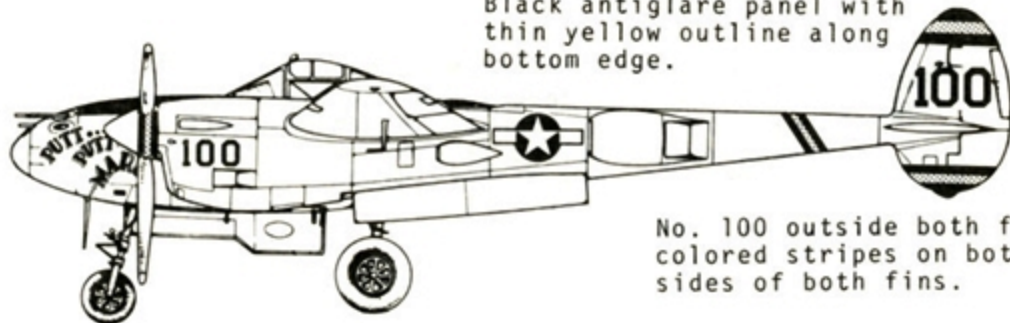

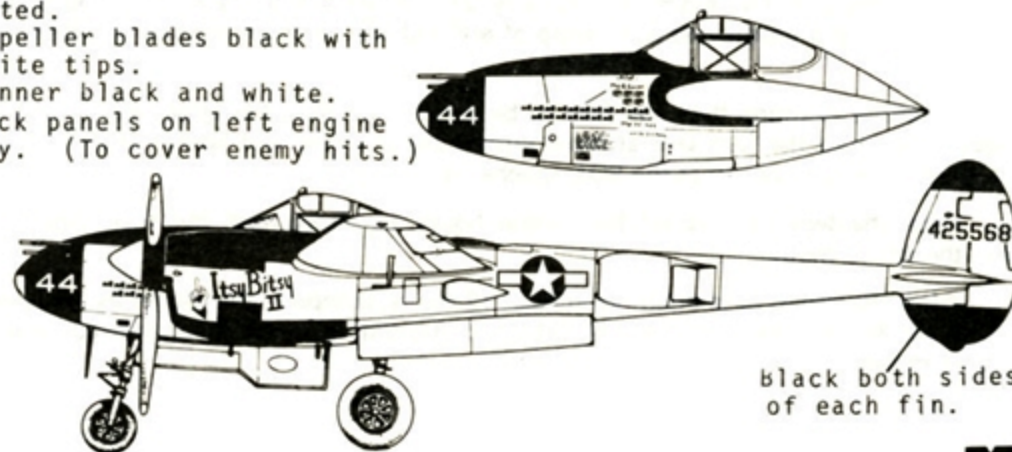
