Pilot's Notes

Propeller logos are individually printed, or printed along with the spec table giving the correct positioning. Cut out one at a time as required using a sharp blade. Soak airscale decals in water to use.

Tips: Decals adhere better to gloss surfaces. If required, use decal setting solution to adhere to raised details. Test fit to ensure alignment. Cut out or trim decals using a very sharp blade to avoid tearing. Store decals in a dark, dry place.
