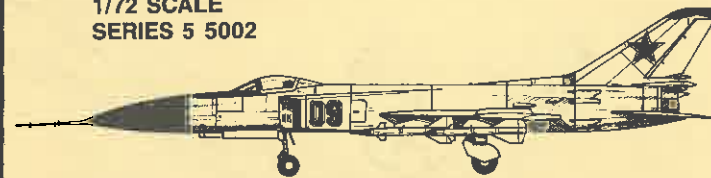

SUKHOI SU - 21F FLAGON

SUKHOI SU - 21 FLAGON F

Originally identified by NATO forces as SU - 15 Flagon F, the SU - 21 is quite a superior aircraft to its earlier namesake, the SU - 15 Flagon A (see Pioneer 2 kit Number 5001).

The Flagon F entered service in 1975 as a high performance all weather interceptor and it is in this role that the aircraft achieved notoriety by shooting down a South Korean Boeing 747 in 1983. Otherwise, its service history has been relatively uneventful, in common with many 1970 aircraft from both sides of the Curtain.

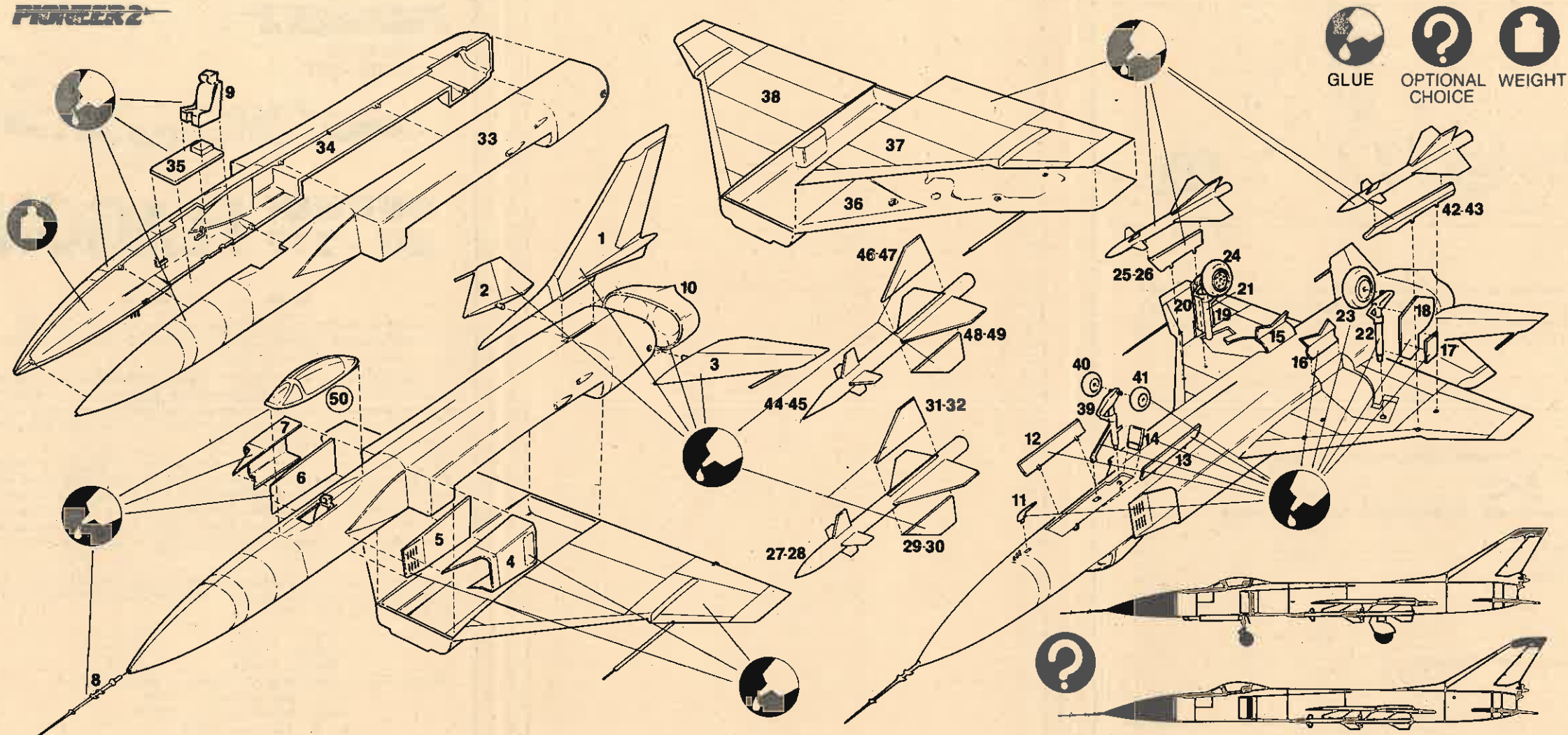
The longer - span wing has first introduced on the Flagon D, its compound sweep produced by reducing the sweepback at the tips via a very narrow unswept section, giving the aircraft much greater manoeuvrability. An ogival nose radome identifies the 'F' from any of the other marques. The lack of power in early Flagon versions was overcome by introduction of two Tumansky R-13F2-300 Turbojets, giving 15875lbs. thrust with afterburning.

Armament usually comprises AA - 3 Anab and AA - 8 Aphid missiles mounted on four underwing pylons. Two underbelly pylons can be used for gun pods or fuel tanks.
