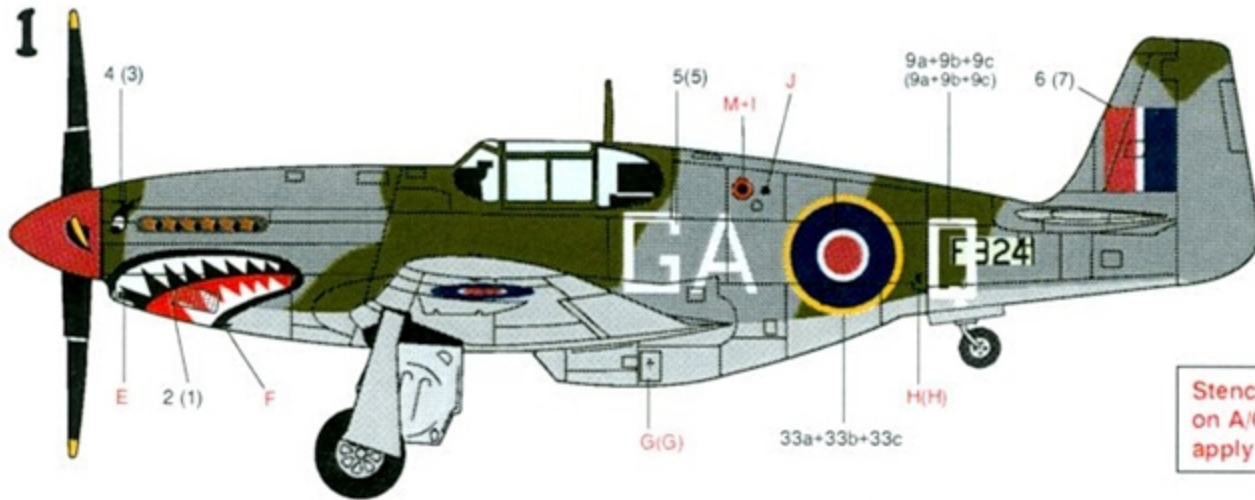

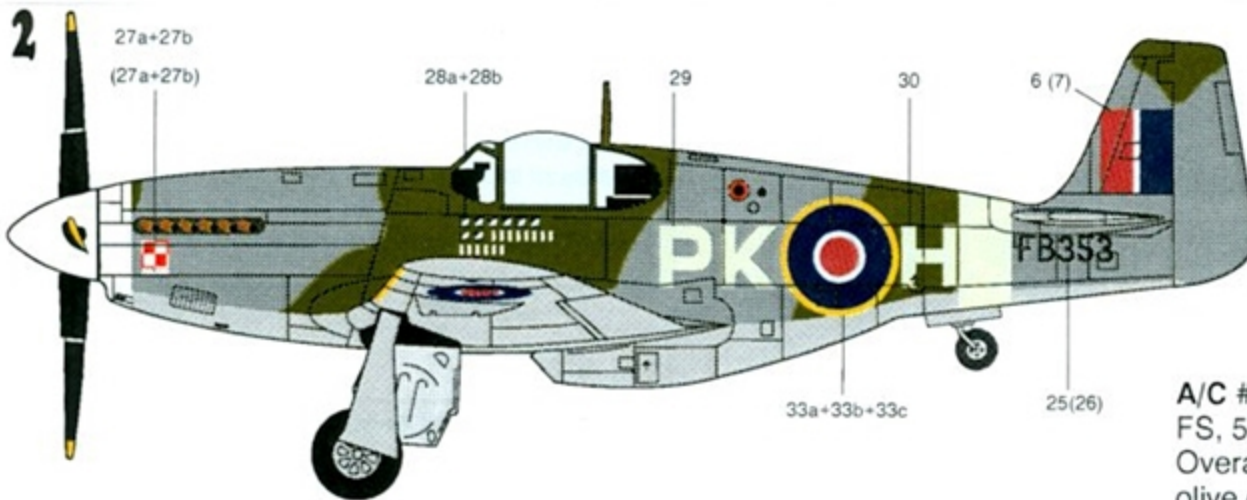

Stencils are shown on A/C #1 only, but apply to all Aircraft.

**A/C #1:** Mustang III, FB241,112 "Shark" Squadron, 239th Fighter Bomber Wing, Desert Air Force, Italy 1945. The upper surface camouflage consisted of the standard RAF ocean gray & dark green over medium sea gray. The spinner was RAF dull red. While British Mustangs apparently did not carry the U.S. data block, several extra data blocks (decals 39 & 40) are provided should you wish to add them. Photo on page 32 in Action book.

**A/C #2:** Mustang III, FB353, No 316 (Polish) Sq., England, November 1944. The upper surface camouflage consisted of the standard RAF ocean gray & dark green over medium sea gray. The spinner and forward fuselage stripe were white and the rear fuselage stripe was sky. The leading edge of the main wing had a yellow stripe.



**A/C #3:** P-51B 42-106957, 26th FS, 51st FG, China, Fall 1944. Overall duraluminum finish with olive drab anti-glare panel. Yellow & black bands were applied on the fin, rudder & fuselage.
