F4U-1 CORSAIR COCKPIT STENCILS AND PLACARDS

This decal set is designed for the Tamiya 1/32 F4U Corsair kits, but can be adapted to fit any 1/32 F4U Corsair kit.

The cockpit of the Corsair is covered with stencils and placards reminding the pilot of which switch does what. This sheet supplies all of these markings, with a number of markings that are specific to certain Corsair subtypes from the F4U-1 Birdcage through the F4U-1D. It is up to the modeler to determine which marking is appropriate for his specific model.

- 1) Decals work best on painted surfaces with a gloss finish. Setting solutions can be used, but let the decals sit in place on the model for a few minutes before applying.
- 2) These decals are tiny, so work slowly and carefully.
- 3) Larger decals, such as 22 and 48, may be best cut into smaller sections and applied individually, allowing them to lay down between the rows of raised switches and knobs.
- 4) When dry, seal decals with a flat or satin clearcoat.

Letter W below signifies a non-standard or Warbird position for stencil 10. W suffix denotes Warbird fit.
