 Light Grey radome, Black anti-glare panel and intake lips and cones



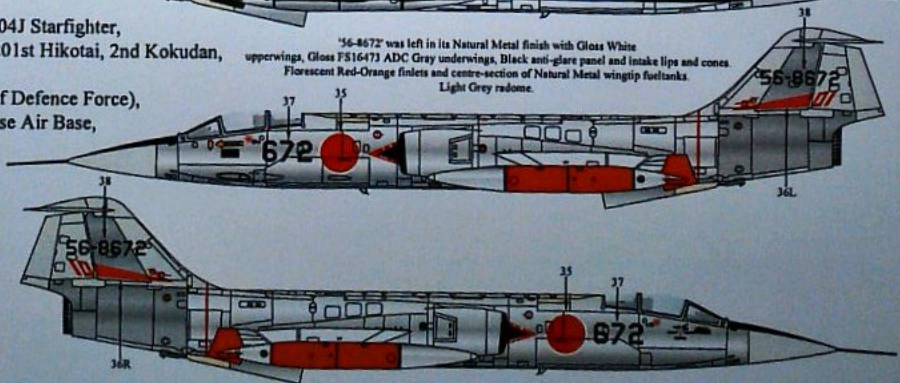

 and RAL6014 Gelboliv with Aluminium undersides, Light Grey radome, Black anti-glare panel and intake lips and cones.



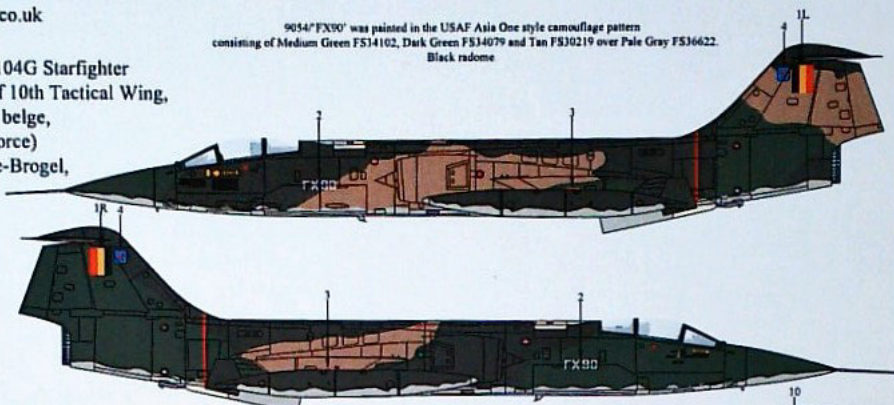

 Light Grey radome.



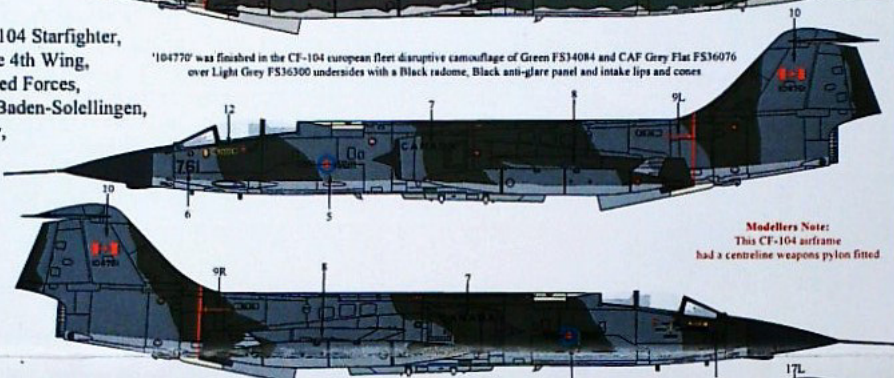
