

## Dutch armored vehicles between the world wars

Carden Loyd 1/76.

in 1932 5 Carden Loyd tankettes where bought by the Dutch.

These vehicles where given names of big cats, This decal set has the decals for 1 vehicle, the Lynx. I didn't find any photo's of the lynx with the K.R.A. letters so they are not included in this set. this set prvides markins for the Lynx in the 1932-39 period. Lincenceplate on the front and rear, the name on boht sides and a nattional flag on the front of the vehicle on the horizontal panel just in front of the crew hatches. color suggestion is an overall deep dark green color.

Kit suggestions are the carden loyd tankette of Convoy models or the Dutch Cardenloyd made by Earlywarminiatures.

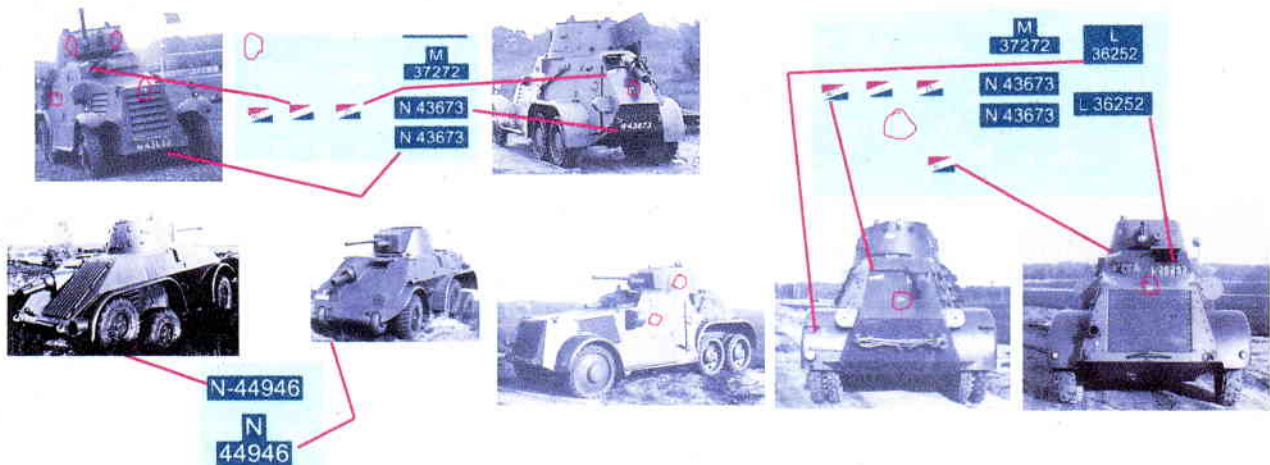


Dutch Morris armored truck.

Based on a morris commercial chassis . The Dutch artillery workshop made 3 of these trucks. They where given names of cows: Buffel, Bison, Wisent. This set provides decals for 1 vehicle, the Buffel. This is the vehicle with the most known foto's. on the front, low on the vehicle 1 licence plate, on the windshields the dutch national insigna with reg.number andd on the other side the labe "60" one name on each side of the vehicle. color suggestion is an overall dark green. kit suggestion, the Morris Buffel from MGM models.

Landsverk m36 and m38

In the late 1930's the dutch bought a total of 11 landsverk M36 and 13 landsverk M38 armored vehicles. These Swedish vehicles where addapted to dutch requirements wich included a 4cm AT-gun. This set provides markings for one M36 and one M38 in the late 30's period but NOT the mobilisation period. Kit suggestions are, M36 and M38 from Retrokit France / Solfig, or M36 from SHQ miniatures. color would be an overall dar green.



Daf M39

In the late 30's the Dutch produced an armored vehicle on their own. The Daf M39 was the result, only seeing very little action during the war of 1940. This set provides decals for the prototype vehicle. there where several small differences between the production and prototype vehicle. the prototype only had 2 licence plates. color suggestion would be overall dark green. kit suggestion would be the older retrokit M39 or the WESPE kit. the newer Retrokit and Tasmotels offering is the production vehicle.

Wilton Fijenoord.
